CONTINUING STUDENTS

NEW STUDENTS

The session consists of students participating in a group orientation session to discuss and review course selection and scheduling, enrolment and use of the Lecture Schedule and Atkinson Calendar. Enrolment blocks on the Voice Response Enrolment System will remain in place until such time as new students contact OSAS to book an advising appointment. Faculty Transfers: Students from other York faculties who are interested in transferring to Atkinson can call or come into OSAS to obtain further information regarding requirements to transfer. Successful faculty transfer students will be required to meet with an advisor.
